

The Application, Interview, and Resume Contest is designed to expose older 4-H members to the job application and interview process, as well as potential careers available in the River Valley District.

This is a mock contest. While the job descriptions and additional job lists are positions within each of the companies, 4-H members are not applying for an actual job but should understand these companies may be potential employers in the future.

WHO: Youth must be an enrolled 4-H member and between ages 16-18 (4-H age) before January 1, 2024.

Three companies in the River Valley District have provided a job description for a position within their business that a person could secure directly out of high school.

The three companies are Central Valley Ag, Polansky Seed, and United Bank and Trust. These three companies have also provided a list of additional jobs within their companies with the required level of education and preferred degree if college education is required.



WHAT: The 4-H member will select one of the three job descriptions to complete an application, cover letter, resume, and interview. The application and K-State Research and Extension's publications on completing a cover letter, resume, and interview can be found on our website at https://www.rivervalley.k-state.edu/4-h/air_contest.html.

The completed application, cover letter, and resume are due to your local River Valley District Extension Office by February 5, 2024.

Interviews will be scheduled for each member that completes an application, cover letter, and resume. The interviews will be held during District 4-H Club Day on Saturday, February 10, 2024, at the Republic County Junior/Senior High School in Belleville. A representative from each of the four companies will be conducting the interviews. The interview schedule will be released with the District 4-H Club Day schedule.

AWARDS: All participating members will receive a ribbon placing. The four Top Purple individuals will be ranked and receive the following cash prize as donated by the four participating companies.
